The only force in the world that could hold Jesus on that cross was the grace that His death would provide so that our sins could be forgiven. *Matthew 27:54*

I. Jesus Died an Expected Death. *1 Peter 1:18-20 NIV*

Genesis 3:15 NIV; Psalm 22:7-8,15-18; Isaiah 53:5,7 NIV; Matthew 16:21 NIV

II. Jesus Died a Voluntary Death.

Luke 22:42; John 10:17-18 NIV; Luke 9:22

III. Jesus Died a Distinctive Death:

- At noon, the sun goes dark. *Luke 23:44-45*
- The Temple curtain was ripped in two.
- "Life-change" that happened as Jesus died. *Mark 15:39 NIV*

IV. Jesus Died an Atoning Death.

To atone is to unite two divided parties and make them "at-one." *1 Corinthians 15:3 NIV*

Jesus' death was an atoning substitutionary death.

On the cross Jesus could save Himself or save us, but He could not possibly do both.

The heart of our problem is a problem with our heart!

There is one "last minute" conversion in the Bible so no one would think it's too late. There is only one so no one would be presumptuous and foolish. *2 Corinthians 5:21 NIV*
